## \*Label all your child's personal belongings

*The Complete Illustrated Children's Bible by Harvest Kids or NLT Bible (Suggested for 2nd Grade Learners)
*Backpack (No movie/cartoon/book characters allowed)
*Lunch box (No movie/cartoon/book characters allowed) stainless steel or plastic lunch container Please Do
Not send your child's lunch in plastic ziplock bags, use reusable containers/bags to store food and save leftovers
*Water Bottle (No movie/cartoon/book characters allowed) we recommend 26 oz in size since it is easier for
them to hold. The water bottle will travel back and forth with your child's lunchbox, we encourage you to add ice.

*1 Hat/Cap Note: We encourage each child to wear a hat during outdoor play in the warm weather. This cap will
be stored in their backpack.
1 Pair of Rain Boots (These will be requested later in the year)

## **Important Information:**

- **No Movie/Cartoon/Book Characters Allowed** on ANY of your child's personal belongings: backpack, lunchbox, water bottle, hat, etc.
- Backpacks: must be maintained clean and neat with only what is essential (planner, green folder, lunchbox, water bottle, and depending on the weather a hat/sweater/jacket daily).
- Food: Keep in mind that we are a Peanut and Candy Free School. Save special treats for home/car rides.
- Include appropriate **cooling packs** in your child's lunch. Unfortunately, the fridge is not available for learners' lunch items. Also, **we are limiting the use of microwaves this year**. There will be one microwave for all the learners to use.
- Lunch Ideas such as tree nuts, dried fruit, fruit, veggies, bars, muffins etc.
- Birthday Festivities: Send a fruit platter, fruit cups, muffins, cookies, and/or toy goody bags to enjoy with
  the class after lunchtime. Parents are welcome to attend. Notify your child's guide prior to the birthday
  celebration.
- **Aftercare:** If your child is enrolled in the aftercare program, send a **hearty snack** Labeled Snack ( <u>stainless steel or plastic container</u>) for your child to enjoy during after-school-care.
