*Label your child's personal belongings

	*Backpack (No movie/cartoon/book characters allowed)
	*Water Bottle (No movie/cartoon/book characters allowed) - we recommend 26 oz for your child
	to hold. The water bottle will travel back and forth with your child's lunchbox, we encourage you to
	add ice.
	*Lunch Box (No movie/cartoon/book characters allowed) stainless steel or plastic lunch container
	Note: Your child will be learning to open their own lunches and we want them to feel independent and
	not frustrated. Please Do Not send your child's lunch in plastic ziplock bags, use reusable
	containers/bags to store food and save leftovers.
	*Snack Box or Bag: Labeled Snack - <u>stainless steel or plastic container</u> . Note: Please label AM & PM
	snacks and place them in a separate container/bag inside their backpack.
	*Roll-up nap mat (No additional blankets or pillows, the roll-up nap mat comes with a set) Nap
	Mat will be stored on your child's hook and will be sent home on Thursday's for you to wash. 1 small
	stuffed animal or blankie for naptime - must fit in their backpack.

	2 Packs of Crayola Markers
	1 Pack of Cardstock Paper
	1 Pack of Expo Dry Erase Markers (Thick)
	*1 Hat/Cap Note: We encourage each child to wear a hat during outdoor play in the warm weather.
	This cap will be stored in their backpack.
	1 Pair of Rain Boots (These will be requested later in the year)
	*An extra change of clothes stored in your child's backpack (shirt, underwear, pants, socks, do not send shoes). It must be VOG athletic wear and must be changed out every season.

Important Information:

- No Movie/Cartoon/Book Characters Allowed on ANY of your child's personal belongings: backpack, lunchbox, water bottle, hat, etc.
- Backpacks: must be maintained clean and neat with only what is essential (green folder, lunchbox, snack container, water bottle, extra change of clothes, and depending on the weather a hat/sweater/jacket daily).
- A green rain suit will be assigned to your child at the beginning of the year. All rain suits are VOG property.
- Food: Keep in mind that we are a Peanut and Candy Free School. Save special treats for home/car rides. Send snacks in reusable containers or bags.
- Include appropriate cooling packs in your child's lunch. Unfortunately, the fridge is not available for learners' lunch items. Also, we are limiting the use of microwaves this year. There will be one microwave for all the learners to use
- Lunch Ideas & Snack Ideas such as tree nuts, dried fruit, fruit, veggies, bars, muffins etc.
- A.M. Snack Time: Send a hearty morning snack for your child to enjoy. Our snack time is 15 minutes each day. (If possible, NO yogurt/dairy liquids, this is helpful for managing time and avoiding cleaning up spills during our short AM snack).
- Birthday Festivities: <u>Send a fruit platter/cups, mini cupcakes/muffins, or cookies</u> to enjoy with the class after lunchtime or for the morning snack. Parents are welcome to attend. Notify your child's guide prior to the birthday celebration. Note: Homemade or store purchased muffins or cookies are welcome.
- Aftercare: If your child is enrolled in the aftercare program, send a hearty snack Labeled Snack (<u>stainless steel</u> or <u>plastic container</u>) for your child to enjoy during after-school-care.
